



Production Supervisor – Aquamonitrix

Company Background:

T.E. Laboratories is a science-based SME based in Tullow, Co. Carlow, Ireland. The company operates a number of divisions which includes R&D and NPD activities.

R&D activities include participation in European and National collaborative funded projects. To date the company has participated in 8 FP7's, coordinated 1 FP7 project and 2 H2020. The company is actively looking to increase project participation under the Horizons 2020 program. Outputs from these projects and other innovation processes within the company produce initial prototypes that then need to be taken down a commercialisation path.

NPD (New Product Development) activities include progressing any selected projects from that R&D pipeline through an NPD process, to bring the concept to full commercial launch, with the resulting products transferred into full production.

Role:

This is an exciting opportunity to join a new production department, the production supervisor is required to supervise and support activities across the area of production of products from NPD. The successful candidate must be capable of interfacing with the various disciplines within the company – primarily NPD and Operations, but also Quality, and Purchasing. Experience in working well independently, within a team, managing team projects and meeting strict deadlines is an advantage.

Reporting to the Operations Manager, the successful candidate will work closely on meeting production deadlines.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Supervision of production assembly and scheduling workloads for production team.
- Responsible for assembly of products.
- Ensure all production staff are trained against a skills matrix.
- Ensure all production practices are in accordance with appropriate standards.
- Quality check of all raw materials at goods receipt stage.
- Ensure stock levels of components used for assembly do not fall below minimum quantity.

Experience and Qualifications:

Minimum Leaving Certificate or equivalent and min 3/4 years industry experience in a similar role, previous Supervisory experience preferable.

Candidates will be assessed on the following competencies:

- Previous experience in a technical manufacturing environment would be desirable
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills
- Excellent attention to detail
- Ability to work under one's own initiative as well as part of a team
- Time management skills, ability to prioritize workloads
- Team player
